

SUPERLOGOFF

- <1> Get LISTU PCBF column number for the port to logoff (put in debugger)
- <2> Turn your own debug on: >DEBUG-ON portnumber
- <3> Send a break to terminal you are on: CTRL+BREAK (ALT+B) in Procomm for Windows
- <4> In system debugger (you should see an exclamation point - this is the system debugger),
type:
! .pcbf#.108;8 <RETURN>
... you will see a long number and the = sign. Type:
=.0000001C8000000 <RETURN>
...you will be back at the exclamation point
- <5> Type 'G' to go back to TCL.
- <6> Tandem port and it should be at system debugger (!)
- <7> Type 'END' to get it back to TCL
- <8> Un-tandem - You're done!

TO LOGOFF A PORT THAT WILL NOT LOG OFF WITH 'OFF' OR 'END' IN THE SYSTEM DEBUGGER, TYPE <G4.2><RETURN>
